## Keynote Presenter Barbara Reid, OP

Barbara E. Reid, O.P. is a Dominican Sister of Grand Rapids, Michigan. She holds a Ph.D. in Biblical Studies from The Catholic University of America in Washington, D.C., an M.A. in Religious Studies as well as an B.A. from Aquinas College in Grand Rapids, MI. She is Vice President and Academic Dean and Professor of New Testament Studies at Catholic Theological Union in Chicago. She is immediate past President of the Catholic Biblical Association of America.

## Keynote Presenter Steve Bevans, SVD

Steve Bevans is a priest in the Society of the Divine Word (SVD). He is Professor of Mission and Culture, Emeritus, at Catholic Theological Union, Chicago, where he has taught since 1986. He has written and lectured extensively, and has just completed a semester teaching at the University of Divinity in Melbourne, Australia. Steve is currently a member of the World Council of Churches' Commission on World Mission and Evangelism.

#### **Transportation**

The RBC will provide limited transportation to and from the Milwaukee airport (MKE) on Saturday and Tuesday. During registration, please indicate that you will need a ride from the airport.
